We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is biblically essential.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Isaiah 59:2 *But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.*

Romans 10:9-10 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.



What is salvation?

Jesus answers this question in a conversation with Nicodemus in John 3:3-8. He explains that we are born again through the Spirit of God.

God's free gift of grace is our salvation from sin.

Why do we need salvation?

Our sin has separated us from God.

Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

God cannot be in the presence of sinful man because of his holiness. His solution was to send his son, Jesus, to die for our sin so that we can be reconciled to him once again.

How do we receive salvation?

It is through God's grace and Jesus' sacrifice that we receive salvation.

When we confess our sin to Jesus and believe that he is God's son, then we receive his forgiveness and salvation.
